

**Revision B of the
Constitution and By-Laws of the
Shell Point Sailboard Club, Inc.**

Promulgated by the Board of Directors of 2026

Procedure

1. 25% of the membership sign a petition to allow the board to make changes.
2. The entire Constitution and By-Laws were carefully reviewed, and changes are based on current procedures norms.
3. The changed constitution will be posted in the newsletter in June, July, and August.
4. The revisions will be read and discussed as necessary, and the changes will be voted on at the September business meeting.

Summary of changes

1. Membership shall be composed of at least sixty percent (60%) owning sailboards, changed from seventy-five percent (75%).
2. Non-resident membership type was eliminated as we have never had one. We do have non-residents that are members at the \$35 rate.
3. Changed board meeting quorum from two-thirds majority (6/9) to a simple majority (5/9).
4. Dues and fees were raised from \$30 to \$35 annually for a single membership and from \$45 to \$50 for a family membership.
5. Under Section 4 of the By-Laws, the Board can now approve up to \$500 in expenditure up from the \$250 threshold previously.
6. Under Section 4 of the By-Laws, the need for two signatures for withdrawals over \$500 was changed to the need for one signature.
7. Under Section 4 of the By-Laws, the Purser is no longer backed by the Commodore or the Vice Commodore but by a Purser designee who has full access to the club account.
8. Eliminated all permanent committees in Section 6 of the By-Laws since they have never been formed.
9. General grammatical corrections per Microsoft Copilot.
